Come Prepared! Create your Federal Student Aid (FSA) ID. To complete the FAFSA, students, and parent(s) must create a FSA ID at fsaid.ed.gov.

- FSA ID
- Student/parent 2021 income tax returns (1040s) and W-2s
- Driver's license, if you have one
- Social security card, if you have one
- Alien registration card, if you have one
- Individual taxpayer identification number (ITIN), if you have one
- List of colleges you are interested in attending
- Most current bank statements
- Any records of untaxed income, pensions, disability benefits, IRS contributions, veterans' benefits, and child support payments received or paid
